- High School diploma equivalent to Dutch mbo4, havo or vwo diploma, e.g. IB diploma with 24 points, IBCP, Hochschulreife or Fachhochschulreife. Check our website for **more accepted diploma's**.
- A pass in Mathematics (minimum equivalent to havo level 6.0) or a pass in the deficiency test at Windesheim before 1 May.
- A pass in English (minimum equivalent to havo level 6.0) or in your English proficiency test (IELTS 6.5, TOEFL or Cambridge B2-C1).
- Admission essay
- 2 recommendation letters
- Online matching test
- Personal interview
- Group activity
